When students are in College uniform, they are representing our College. Therefore we appreciate your support by ensuring the uniform is worn in the correct manner and garments are kept in good condition.

The Emmaus Christian College uniform and accessories are unique (except shoes) and is only available from the Uniform Shop, located on the South Plympton campus, behind the Canteen.

We understand that the cost of a complete College uniform is a large initial financial outlay so we have made every effort to source the lowest prices balanced with durable, high-quality fabrics.

## Uniform Policy

Thank you your support in ensuring our uniform and grooming requirements are maintained at a high standard.

### **Emmaus Christian College expectations:**

- Parents will ensure that students are well presented by providing correct uniform items and ensuring that students are wearing the correct uniform every day.
- Full uniform will be worn to and from school and it will be clean, neatly worn and in good repair.
- Students will take pride in their appearance and maintain high standards of personal grooming.
- Uniform items will be clearly named and students will be responsible for their belongings at all times.

# Grooming and Accessories

**Dress and Skirt** Minimum length top of knee cap

**Trousers** Secondary Boys – compulsory when representing the College externally for formal occasions. Teachers will advise when necessary, eg Debating, formal excursions, musical performances

**Hair** Neat, tidy, conservative style, neatly combed, off the face, fringe above eyebrows, natural colour, no extreme colours or stripes

Girls – shoulder length hair to be tied back from face, plain navy blue or white accessories

Boys – above collar, cut no lower than no. 3 or at Principal's discretion

Year 12 Boys ONLY – well groomed, conservative facial hair permitted

**Hat** ELC/Junior/Secondary – College navy blue bucket hat

Students are required to wear the College hat whilst outdoors during

Term 1 and 4 and as required at other times

**Jewellery** Watch, no other jewellery

Girls – single plain silver or gold stud/sleeper/discreet diamanté stud in each ear lobe

Boys – no earrings are permitted

# Grooming and Accessories

<b>Make-up</b>	Junior – none  Secondary – natural looking, inconspicuous
<b>Tattoos</b>	Emmaus students are not permitted to have any permanent or semi-permanent tattoo (or similar) that is visible in any form of the Emmaus uniform, including sports singlets and at swimming carnivals. It is not appropriate for a tattoo to be covered by a bandage (or similar) in an area that would otherwise be visible
<b>Nail Polish</b>	Junior – not permitted  Secondary – clear only
<b>Scarf</b>	Emmaus scarf with school colours
<b>Gloves</b>	Navy blue only
<b>School Bag</b>	College logo, no stickers/graffiti, for ID 1-2 key tags acceptable
<b>Shoes</b>	Plain, black, closed leather lace-up school shoe with black laces.
<b>Sport Shoes</b>	Sport days/PE lessons only – Quality sport shoe with sole, ankle and arch support.
<b>Socks</b>	College socks. Black socks worn with trousers (Secondary boys)
<b>Stockings</b>	Plain black 50/60 denier (winter – Secondary girls)
<b>Blazer</b>	Year 11 and 12 – compulsory Year 7 to 10 – optional

## **Clothing to and from school for extra warmth during winter -**

Plain navy jackets/coats can be worn, removed on arrival and kept in lockers.

# Second Hand Uniforms

We supply a limited range of second hand uniforms with no exchange or refund.

If you would like to resell your uniform, please consider the condition of your garments as we cannot accept clothing that is faded, stained, has holes or is an out-dated design. Due to health reasons, we cannot accept second hand shoes, hats or socks.

## **How to prepare your garments for second hand sale**

- Please wash or dry clean and press all items (this may increase value of return)
- Stitch up loose hems
- Remove name tags where possible
- Consider the question: “Would I buy this second-hand for my child?”
- Place items on a hanger in a bag along with a completed [Second Hand Uniform for Resale Form](#) and return to the Uniform Shop during open times or at Student Services.

<b>Track pants</b>	Navy blue, gold piping, College logo
<b>Jacket</b>	Navy blue, gold piping, College logo
<b>Girls dress</b>	Blue and white stripe, College logo Optional for girls during Term 1 and 4 The jacket and/or rugby jumper are NOT to be worn with the dress.
<b>Jumper</b>	Navy blue, College logo, with girls dress only
<b>Socks</b>	College socks
<b>Shoe</b>	Junior School are required to have two pairs of shoes: <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Plain black lace up school shoes with black laces. Velcro is optional from F to Year 2.</li><li>2. Quality sport shoes for PE days only. The preferred colours are navy/white/black. Velcro is optional from F to Year 2.</li></ol>

# Secondary School Uniform Expectations

Year 7 - 12

## Sport Uniform

- Year 7-9 PE, Dance and Drama lessons: Sports Uniform is worn on days that students have practical PE lessons, Dance or Drama lessons. Students may come to and from the College in their sport uniform without changing at the College on these days.
- Year 10-12 Dance: Sport Uniform, but still changing for the lesson.
- Year 10-12 Drama: To stay in formal uniform and change at school.
- Regardless of the number of days a student is able to wear their Sport uniform, all students are required to have a full set of regular College summer and winter uniform.
- There will be occasions, including sport tryouts, when students are required to come changed for their scheduled school day. Students will be made aware of

## Uniform Seasons

The summer uniform is to be worn during Term 1 and Term 4.

The winter uniform is to be worn during Term 2 and Term 3.

During Terms 2 and 3, the Summer uniform is permitted when the temperature is 24C or over, as forecast by the BOM at 4pm the day prior.

<b>Blazer</b> Optional - Year 7 to 10. Compulsory - Year 11 and 12	Navy blue poly/wool, College logo
<b>Socks</b>	College socks
<b>Shoes</b>	Plain, black, closed leather lace-up school shoe with black laces. No 'chunky' heels.

## WINTER UNIFORM

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<b>Shirt</b>	Blue chambray, short or long sleeve, College logo Long sleeve must be tucked in. Long sleeve shirt cannot be worn with shorts at anytime
<b>Trousers or shorts</b>	Charcoal grey College fabric
<b>College tie</b> (Year 11 and 12)	1 provided to students at no cost (must be worn Term 2 & 3)
<b>Jumper</b>	Navy blue, College logo
<b>Blazer</b> Optional - Year 7 to 10. Compulsory - Year 11 and 12	Navy blue poly/wool, College logo
<b>Shoes</b>	A per summer uniform
<b>Socks</b>	Black socks with trousers

<b>Culotte</b>	Navy blue
<b>Blouse</b>	Blue chambray, short sleeve, College logo Worn with Culotte
<b>Blazer</b> Optional - Year 7 to 10. Compulsory - Year 11 and 12	Navy blue poly/wool, College Logo
<b>Socks</b>	College socks (no stockings with summer uniform)
<b>Shoes</b>	Plain, black, closed leather lace-up school shoe with black laces. No 'chunky' heels.

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<b>Blouse</b>	Blue chambray, short or long sleeve, College logo
<b>Skirt</b>	College fabric
<b>Trousers</b>	Charcoal grey College fabric (black socks with trousers)
<b>Culottes</b>	Worn with socks

<b>Blazer</b> Optional - Year 7 to 10. Compulsory - Year 11 and 12	Navy blue, College logo
<b>Stockings</b>	Plain black (50/60 denier)
<b>Socks</b>	College white socks
<b>Shoes</b>	As per summer uniform

Plain, black, closed leather lace-up school shoe with black laces. No 'chunky' heels.

Velcro straps are optional only for Foundation to Year 2.
