**Correct uniform worn daily** - Parents will ensure their child is well presented by providing correct uniform items and ensuring that students wear the correct uniform every day.

**Full, neat and clean uniform** - Full uniform will be worn to and from school and it will be clean, neatly worn and in good condition.

**Pride in appearance and grooming** - Students will take pride in their appearance and maintain high standards of personal grooming.

**Uniforms named and belongings cared for** - Uniform items will be clearly names and students will be responsible for their belongings at all times

*The dress is to be worn in Term 1 and 4 only unless the temperature is 24 degrees celcius or over, as forecasted by the BOM at 4pm the day prior.*

# Secondary School

## Uniform Expectations

Regardless of the number of days a student is able to wear their Sport uniform, all students are required to have a full set of the regular College Summer and Winter uniform.

When students represent the College at an event (e.g., an awards ceremony, inter-school competition, or performance), they are required to wear the 'formal uniform' as determined by the Head of School. Secondary Boys are required to wear trousers and can borrow these from the Uniform Shop for these occasions if necessary.

There will be occasions, including sport tryouts, when changing is required during the course of a school day and students will be made aware of these occasions as directed by the Head of School.

**Students may wear their Sports uniform on the days they have Sports lessons.**

In addition to this:

**Year 7-9 Dance and Drama:** Students may wear their Sports uniform on days when Dance and Drama is taught.

**Year 10-12 Dance:** Students can wear the sports uniform to and from school and change into black athletic wear for the lesson.

**Year 10-12 Drama:** Students wear formal uniform to and from school and may wear shorts underneath their dress for lessons. Purchasing the sports uniform is not a requirement.

## Uniform Seasons

**The summer uniform** is to be worn during Term 1 and Term 4.

**The winter uniform** is to be worn during Term 2 and Term 3.

During Terms 2 and 3, the Summer uniform is permitted when the temperature is 24°C or over, as forecast by the BOM at 4pm the day prior.

# Shoe Guidelines

## Standard School Shoe

Plain, black, closed leather lace-up school shoe with black laces. No ‘chunky’ heels. Does not include ‘mary-jane’ style or black sports sneakers. Velcro straps are optional for Foundation to Year 2 only.

## Sports/PE Shoe

Quality sport shoe with sole, ankle and arch support. Where possible, neutral colours including a single colour or combination of white, blue, grey, black.

Velcro straps are optional for Foundation to Year 2 only.

# Earrings

Girls are permitted to wear a single, plain, silver or gold (not pearl) stud, sleeper or discreet diamanté stud in each ear lobe.

Maximum stud diameter: 5mm  
Maximum sleeper diameter: 15mm

A watch and a single, discreet cross with a discreet chain, worn under the uniform is permitted for Foundation to Year 12.

# Grooming & Accessories

<b>Blazer</b>	Compulsory for Year 11 and 12. Optional for Year 7 to 10.
<b>Dress and Skirt</b>	Minimum length top of knee cap
<b>Gloves</b>	Navy blue only
<b>Hair</b>	Neat, tidy, conservative style, neatly combed, off the face, fringe above eyebrows, natural colour, no extreme colours or stripes.
<i>Girls</i>	Shoulder length hair to be tied back from face, with school colours (blue, yellow, white) black and brown allowed.
<i>F-11 Boys</i>	Above collar, cut no lower than no. 3 or at Principal's discretion.
<i>Year 12 Boys</i>	Well groomed, conservative facial hair permitted.
<b>Hat</b>	ELC students - required to wear all year round. Junior and Secondary - wear whilst outdoors during Term 1 and 4 and as required at other times.
<b>Jewellery</b>	Watch, earrings and discreet cross necklace. Girls earrings - single plain silver or gold stud, sleeper or discreet diamante stud in each ear lobe. Boys - no earrings are permitted
<b>Make-up</b>	Junior School - none. Secondary School Girls - natural looking and inconspicuous
<b>Nail Polish</b>	Junior School make-up not permitted. Secondary School - clear only.
<b>Scarf</b>	Emmaus scarf with school colours
<b>School Bag</b>	College logo, no stickets or graffiti. One or two keyrings acceptable for identification.
<b>Shoes</b>	Plain black, closed leather lace-up shoe with sole, ankle and arch support.
<b>Sports Shoes</b>	Sports Days and Physical Education lessons only. Quality sports shoes with sole, ankle and arch support.
<b>Socks</b>	College socks. Secondary School Boys & Girls - black socks worn with trousers.
<b>Stockings</b>	Plain black from 50 denier worn with Secondary Girls winter skirt.
<b>Tattoos</b>	Emmaus students are not permitted to have any permanent or semi-permanent tattoo that is visable in any form of the Emmaus uniform, including sports singlets and at Swimming Carnivals. It is not appropriate for a tattoo to be covered by a bandage (or similar) in an area that would otherwise be visible.
<b>Trousers</b>	Compulsory for Secondary Boys when representing the College externally for formal occasions such as music performances, inter-school events and formal excursions. Teachers will advise when necessary.
